Target Audience

This program is designed for all level of human service professionals working with either primary mental health or primary substance abuse populations, considering that symptoms related to both occur simultaneously.

Program Description

This program will explore the challenges and solutions when working with people who have co-existing conditions affecting their level of functioning. For many decades, the stigma of substance abuse disorders and treatment have interfered with treated the whole individual, and the same could be said for substance abuse professionals who treat those with mental health conditions. This program addresses the importance of dual diagnosis integrated treatment approaches in the world of evidenced based practices.

Objectives

Upon completion of this program, participants should able to:

- Identify similarities between MH and SA;
- Describe and treat Post-Acute Withdrawal Syndrome;
- Apply screening tools for co-occurring disorders;
- Review assessment and diagnosis considerations for people with multiple disorders;
- Discuss treatment planning goals and objectives;
- Discuss and become familiar with the “Integrated Treatment” approach; and
- Review what the determination of successful treatment principles is.

Brandon Robinson, LCAS, LPC, CCS, has served as Director of Addiction Services for Fellowship Health Resources, Inc since June 2012. He is a Licensed Professional Counselor, Licensed Clinical Addictions Specialist, and Certified Clinical Supervisor. Mr. Robinson also has a private practice in Raleigh where he provides clinical supervision and outpatient counseling. He has worked in settings such as specialized treatment courts, inpatient care for adolescents and adults with co-occurring disorders, in home outpatient care for families and children, and residential services for youth with history of sexual offenses. Mr. Robinson has also been a field task supervisor with the UNC-CH, School of Social Work for the past 4 years and is a training consultant with the SSW/AHEC Training Partnership.

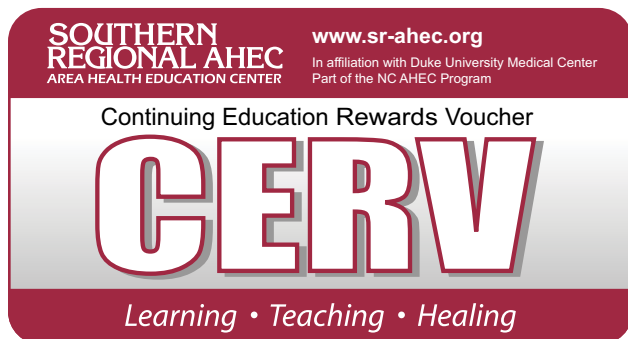
