## **Target Audience**

Mental health professionals including social workers, clinicians, case managers, counselors, psychologists, marriage and family therapists, pastoral counselors, substance abuse counselors, health and human service practitioners, and others interested in this subject.

## **Program Description**

This program is designed to introduce substance use disorder and/or mental health clinicians to the field of gender responsive substance use disorder treatment (for women). Research in substance use disorder treatment indicates that women are best served when treatment is tailored to fit their unique needs. Increased understanding of those needs, and evidence based means (interventions, techniques, ancillary services, etc.) to address them are important for improving the lives of individuals and their families. Participants will be exposed to Seeking Safety, Helping Women Recover, and A Woman's Addiction Workbook as tools for serving the needs of women in outpatient substance use treatment settings. Participants will leave the session with a deeper understanding of their personal process in working with women, the need for gender responsive treatment, and specific tools for providing care to women that suffer from addictive disorders.

## **Objectives**

Upon completion of this workshop, participants will be able to:

- Describe the evolution of gender responsive treatment;
- Identify biological, social, and psychological factors that are unique to women and their experience of addiction and recovery;
- Describe the influence of these factors on addiction treatment for women;
- Identify and discuss existing evidence based and promising practices;
- Discuss the application of presented EBP's for participants' clinical practice; and
- Identify ongoing questions and challenges for the field.

## **Speakers**

**Andrea Winker, LCAS, LCSW** interest in gender and trauma related issues began as an undergraduate at James Madison University where she received her Bachelor's Degree in Interdisciplinary Social Science. She moved to North Carolina in 2005 to work with adolescent females in a wilderness setting and was inspired to pursue her MSW at UNC - Chapel Hill. While at The UNC School of Social Work, she completed the Certificate in Substance Abuse Studies. Ms. Winkler worked for the Duke Family Care Program, providing outpatient substance abuse treatment to pregnant and parenting women.

She has since worked in the Duke Psychiatric Outpatient Clinic, specializing in mental health assessment and brief therapy. In 2010 she began designing training on gender and trauma related issues and has since provided full-day workshops, talks, and webinars on these topics for mental health providers.
