

- *Are you a nurse in North Carolina with an inactive or lapsed license for 5 years or more?*
- *Would you like to re-enter the workforce at your own convenience?*
- *Have you heard about the RN Refresher Program?*

The Nurse Refresher Program is for registered nurses who have at some time been licensed in one of the 50 states. If you are a nurse who has had a lapsed or inactive license for five years or more you must enroll in the RN Refresher Program to return to clinical practice.

Option 1 includes a self study correspondence course that is approved for 140 contact hours, which is the equivalent to 14 Continuing Education Hours. This option also includes successful completion of the clinical practicum. This clinical practicum provides an additional 160 hours (16 CEUs). Cape Fear Valley Health System, Highsmith-Rainey, Moore Regional and Womack Army Medical Center are some of the approved clinical sites.

Option 2 is for nurses who have been practicing during the past five years and desire to expand their knowledge base in the field of medical-surgical nursing, you may choose to enter into the correspondence course alone. (Note that this option does not by itself satisfy eligibility requirements for relicensure in North Carolina.)

The program allows nine months for completion, but many nurses are able to finish in four to six months.
