## **Target Audience**

This workshop will be beneficial to all mental health practitioners who work with adult clients whose struggle with anger (in the present and/or about their past) serves as an obstacle to living more effective and balanced lives. This includes clinical social workers, psychologists, counselors, substance abuse professionals, psychiatric nurses, and case managers.

## **Program Description**

Despite the absence of a diagnostic category for anger disorders, anger is often problematic for many clients presenting with depression, grief, shame, trauma/PTSD, ADHD or certain personality disorders. Left untreated, toxic anger is strongly associated with increased risk of coronary heart disease, high blood pressure, aggression and/or domestic violence, substance abuse, as well as conflictual interactions at home and at work.

This workshop will introduce clinicians to the different faces of anger; the widespread impact of anger on one's overall functioning; and a variety of techniques to assist clients who are motivated to alter their anger expression patterns and to find greater peace within as well as in their interpersonal relationships with others.

# **Objectives**

Upon completion of this workshop, participants will be able to:

- Explain various expressions and functions of anger;
- Describe the biopsychosocial effects of anger;
- Examine how emotional regression fuels the anger response;
- Demonstrate an understanding of various techniques for managing past & present anger; and
- Discuss how mindfulness, radical acceptance and shame resilience aid in moving through and letting go of anger.

Her interests focus on the treatment and resolution of relational, developmental, and shock trauma; shame resilience and wholehearted living; women's wellness and sexual orientation issues. She runs weekly groups and intensives in The Daring Way™ and Rising Strong™ based on the research of Brené Brown. Kate also provides clinical consultation and supervision to other licensed mental health professionals.

Kate is currently a training consultant with UNC-CH School of Social Work's AHEC Training Partnership. She has also been a field instructor (2001-2004) and an adjust instructor (2010-2014) with the school. She has presented at several workshops in North Carolina on the topics of trauma, treatment of adult female survivors of sexual abuse, anger management, mindful parenting, HIV/AIDS, healthy relationships and women's wellness.
