The Institute of Medicine's report and the National Standards for Culturally and Linguistically Appropriate Services (CLAS) recommend a multilevel approach that enhances the cultural competence of healthcare providers and systems. Providers and organizations need to adopt practices that increase their awareness of the cultural needs of their patients and how they can integrate cultural competence into their provision of care which in turn can lead to enhanced patient health outcomes.

This workshop is designed to increase the knowledge, skills and awareness of primary care nurses in cultural competence in order to support the delivery of excellent patient care regardless of the patient's cultural background. In addition, the workshop will provide an enhanced understanding of social determinants of health in order to enhance the healthcare professional's ability to improve individual and population health and also to advance health equity.
