# **Target Audience**

#### **Program Description**

# KT1 Fundamental Concepts, Screening/Muscle Test & Muscle Applications.

The KT1 course is designed to introduce practitioners to the Kinesio Taping<sup>®</sup> Method. Over the course of this 8 hour class, the instructor will discuss the fundamental concepts of the Kinesio<sup>®</sup> Taping Method and the unique properties and use of Kinesio<sup>®</sup> Tex Tape. During lab sessions, attendees will have ample time to practice screening and muscle testing created for the enhancement of your KT skills and muscle applications for both the upper and lower body. Upon completion of this course, attendees will be able to discuss and apply the Kinesio Taping<sup>®</sup> Method to relax overuse syndromes, stimulate weak muscles, and decrease pain and swelling. In addition to instruction provided by a Certified Kinesio Taping Instructor (CKTI), the attendee will receive 2 full-color Kinesio Taping<sup>®</sup> Method workbooks (KT1 Workbook 1) to augment their training.

# KT2 Advanced Concepts & Corrective Technique (Prerequisite: KT1 course)

The KT2 course builds on material learned in KT1. During this 8 hour class, the instructor will introduce the six Corrective Techniques (Mechanical, Functional, Space, Fascia, Ligament/Tendon, and Lymphatic) and discuss their application in a variety of clinical conditions. During lab sessions, attendees will have ample time to practice applying these techniques to a variety of upper and lower body conditions. Upon completion of this course, attendees will be able to discuss and apply the KT Method to orthopedic & neurological conditions. Attendees will receive Workbook 2 (KT Corrective Techniques and Clinical Applications) to augment their training.

In order for participants to receive credit, they must attend both workshop days. No partial credit will be given.

# Here is what you need to bring:

- Clothing appropriate for taping a lot of muscles (we will be taping almost every part of the body, including Glute Medius). Ladies, Moving Comfort sells a sports bra with detachable shoulder straps. Loose-fitting sports shorts work the best. Tight shorts or capris are not acceptable. Please bring or wear a sweater or sweat shirt as the room temperature tends to be a bit on the cool side.
- Men, less hair is better than more hair, if you actually want to feel the Kinesio Tape® work. You don't need to shave, but if you could trim up a bit that would be great .
- The best pair of scissors that you own. Everyone has to have a pair of scissors sharing is not an option.
