Recognizing the signs and symptoms of oral cancer is key to accurate diagnosis. Explore the signs and symptoms, as well as methods of oral cancer diagnosis. Dental management of the oral cancer patient prior to, during and following surgery, radiotherapy and or chemotherapy is highlighted in this lecture. Expand your understanding of follow-up care and prosthodontic rehabilitation. Highlights will include: treatment and preventive measures for radiation caries, mucositis, infections, xerostomia, and osteoradionecrosis. In response to the rising number of oral cancer in patients, prosthetics is increasingly used for functional as well as esthetic purposes. Learn more about the concepts, principles and techniques in the prosthetic management of the oral cancer patient.


