A Walk in My Shoes: Brief and Effective CBT to Promote Effective Change

Target Audience

This workshop will benefit counselors, social workers, psychologists, and other mental health professionals as well as educators, human service professionals, and community advocates interested in this topic.

Program Description

The purpose of this informative, interactive workshop is to learn brief and effective cognitive behavioral strategies to utilize across settings, and to alter face-value assumptions and perceptions when interacting with and encountering emotionally vulnerable clients (e.g. ,children and adolescents).

In settings where time is at a minimum, and the desire to affect positive change is of upmost importance, this workshop will assist you with gaining clarity on brief tools to effectively promote change in the lives of those you serve. In addition, through real-life case examples, discover that there is often more to an individual's story than its face value, as you learn what it means to walk in someone else's shoes.

Objectives

Upon completion of this workshop, participants will be able to:

- Describe brief and effective cognitive behavioral strategies across multiple settings;
- Identify and name assumptions and perceptions when interacting with and encountering emotionally vulnerable clients;
- List strategies to build rapport and promote trust in the therapeutic interactions with emotionally vulnerable clients; and
- Explore time-sensitive interventions.

Cancellations less than 48 business hours before the program are non-refundable. Participants who register for a program and do not attend will forfeit the full amount of the program registration fee.


