## **Target Audience**

RN Refresher Students, nurses or other healthcare workers desiring a review of basic nursing skills.

# **Program Description**

Proficiency when performing basic nursing skills is an expectation for all nurses. This one day workshop will review and provide hands on opportunity to practice and demonstrate competency for the following nursing skills: sterile gloving; establishing and maintaining a sterile field; insertion and removal of a urinary catheter and nasogastric tube; proper technique for obtaining vital signs; administering intramuscular, subcutaneous, and intradermal injections; correct technique for setting up intravenous equipment (to include priming the intravenous tubing and saline lock), insertion of a peripheral intravenous catheter, and maintaining fluids, discontinuation of intravenous fluids; and applying sterile dressings.

#### **Outcomes**

- Demonstrate appropriate technique for obtaining vital signs, to include temperature, blood pressure, pulse, respirations and pulse oximeter;
- Demonstrate correct technique for administering intramuscular, intradermal, and subcutaneous injections;
- Demonstrate proper technique for applying sterile bandages;
- Demonstrate correct procedure for insertion and removal of a urinary catheter (male and female.);
- Demonstrate correct procedure for insertion and removal of a nasogastric tube;
- Demonstrate correct technique for setting up intravenous equipment (to include priming the intravenous tubing and saline lock), insertion of a peripheral intravenous catheter, and maintaining fluids. Discontinuation of intravenous fluids;
- · Identify correct injection sites;
- Identify and demonstrate correct technique for applying and removing sterile gloves;
- · Identify and demonstrate correct technique for establishing and maintaining a sterile field; and
- Demonstrate and practice skills learned.
