

SPICE - Statewide Program for Dentistry in Infection Control and Epidemiology

Target Audience

New dental staff members, dentists, dental assistants, hygienists and the undertrained designated staff member who has been identified as the person who will oversee the infection control activities in your dental office. It is a requirement that NC requires every location to have a written Infection Control Program and a person who oversees processes on site that has completed a State certified program (SPICE)(0206)

Program Description

The NC Administrative code specifies that each health care organization in the state, including dentistry, shall designate a staff member to direct infection control activities. The designated staff member in each dental office shall complete a course in infection control addressing 7 specific areas. This courses satisfies the required infection control training in a dental setting as mandated by the Statewide Program for Infection Control and Epidemiology (SPICE).

Objectives

Upon completion of this knowledge based program, the participants will be able to:

- Apply epidemiologic principles of infectious disease
- Apply principles and practice of asepsis
- Define sterlization, disinfection and sanitation
- Describe universal blood and body fluid precautions
- Discuss engineering controls to reduce the risk of sharp injuries
- Discuss the disposal of sharps
- Discuss the techniques that reduce the risk of sharp injuries to healthcare workers
- Discuss the additional state laws regarding HIV and Hepatitis B

Speaker

Sheila Lassister, CDA, possess over 26 years of dental experience, She has served as sterilization technician, clinic coordinator, certified dental assistant and office manager. She has recently "retired" as an instructor for an introductory dental assisting course. As the lead instructor, she has taught and trained students regarding General Chairside, Radiology, OSHA, HIPAA and Medical/Dental Office Emergency.

Sheila also is a dental curriculum provider for SPICE (approved through UNC at Chapel Hill), nitrous oxide for Dental Auxiliary, dental radiology for the Office Trained Dental Assistant (both approved by NC State Dental Board) and Licensed Training Provider through American Red Cross for CPR/First Aid/AED and BBP training for healthcare professionals and lay responders.
