This class is designed for any human service professionals interested in this topic.

Program Description

Mental Health First Aid is an evidence-based 8-hour course that teaches you how to help someone who is developing a mental health problem or experiencing a mental health crisis. The training helps you identify, understand, and respond to signs of addictions and mental illnesses.

Objectives

Upon completion of this workshop, participants will be able to:

- Discuss the potential risk factors and warning signs for a range of mental health problems, including: depression, anxiety/trauma, psychosis and psychotic disorders, substance use disorders, and self-injury;
- Describe the prevalence of various mental health disorders in the U.S. and the need for reduced stigma in their communities;
- Identify a 5-step action plan encompassing the skills, resources and knowledge to assess the situation, to select and implement appropriate interventions, and to help the individual in crisis connect with appropriate professional care; and
- Discuss the evidence-based professional, peer, social, and self-help resources available to help someone with a mental health problem.

Terrasine Gardner, M.A. is currently the Community Relations Manager for Alliance Behavioral Healthcare and within this role serves as an Adult Mental Health First Aid Instructor. She has a MA degree in Counseling from Webster University and has a combined total 23 years of experience working within the Mental Health System.
