Program Description

Community Health Workers are a workforce that is gaining recognition for the important impacts they can make on healthcare teams. Demonstrated impact of CHWs includes improving access to care and health outcomes among populations with historically low level of trust in healthcare systems, improving the quality and experience of care, contributing to reductions in cost due to preventable hospitalization and ER use, and contributing to healthcare team well-being by supporting complex patients with unmet social resource needs. There are a lot of questions among healthcare professionals about the roles CHW's can play and how best to integrate them into their teams. The NC CHW Association, NC DHHS Office of Rural Health, NC DHHS Department of Health Benefits, NC AHEC, and Partners In Health are collaborating on a series of live webinars to help answer some of these questions and learn from real life examples of CHW integration in NC. A foundational webinar that reviews the definition, roles, competencies, and settings for CHW integration was held on April 13th, 2023.

In this two-part series, each webinar will feature two healthcare practices with CHW programs sharing more about their models, lessons learned, and demonstrated impact. Honey Estrada, CCHW, MPH, President of NC CHW Association will moderate both webinars and engage each practice team in answering questions following their presentations. Both webinars will be recorded and made available on the NC AHEC website. A live interpretation will be provided.
